



## SCHEME FOR OFFERING OF MIL/ALTERNATIVE ENGLISH

17 (seventeen) Modern Indian Languages (MIL) subjects introduced under the COHSEM:

(1) Assamese	(2) Bengali	(3) Gangte
(4) Hindi	(5) Hmar	(6) Liangmai
(7) Kom	(8) Manipuri	(9) Mao La
(10) Mizo	(11) Nepali	(12) Paite
(13) Ruangmei	(14) Tangkhul	(15) Thadou Kuki
(16) Vaiphei	(17) Zou	

The following conditions should strictly be followed by all the affiliated/recognized institutions under the Council while offering MIL subject(s) by the of students of different communities in Class-XI and Class-XII :

1. Those students who passed the HSLC Examination under the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur and their mother tongue is one of the above 17 (seventeen) MIL subjects, should compulsorily offer their mother tongue as MIL subject in Class-XI and XII. However, those students who have passed the HSLC Examination of the BOSEM with other community dialect as MIL are allowed to change to his/her genuine mother tongue on production of Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority or Alternative English in lieu of MIL.
2. For students offering Elementary Manipuri [Eman (Roman Script)] in HSLC Examination conducted by the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur and willing to offer Alternative English in Class-XI, they are allowed to offer Alternative English.
3. A student of outside Boards/Councils (other than the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur) who offered Alternative English or other dialects in Class-X/XI, may offer Manipuri (Meetei/Meitei Script) as MIL in Class-XI/XII.
4. For students of outside Boards/Councils (other than the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur) offering Hindi/Nepali or any other dialects in Class-X/XI and willing to offer Alternative English in Class-XI/XII, are allowed to offer Alternative English.
5. A student of outside Boards/Councils (other than the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur) who did not offer an MIL from amongst the above 17 (seventeen) dialects in Class-X/XI due to not opening in the previous institution may offer any one of the above 17 (seventeen) dialects or Alternative English in lieu of MIL in Class-XI/XII, provided that the said dialect is opened in the institution in which he/she applies for admission.
6. A student of outside Boards/Councils (other than the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur) who offered an MIL from amongst the above 17 (seventeen) dialects in Class-X/XI, may change the offered MIL to his/her own dialect from amongst the 17 dialects in Class-XI/XII on production of Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority.
7. Those Tribal Students whose mother tongue is included/not included in the above 17 (seventeen) MIL subjects and domiciled in Manipur may offer Alternative English in lieu of MIL in Class-XI/XII on production of Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority.
8. Those Council's Private Candidates who have passed the HSLC Examination of BOSEM in the year 2015 onwards and offered Manipuri as MIL, should appear the Hr. Sec. Examination (Class-XII) of the Council in Meetei/Meitei script in lieu of Bengali script. However, for the candidate(s) before 2015, they should appear Alternative English in lieu of Manipuri (MIL) in the Hr. Sec. Examination of the Council (Class-XII).
