Instruction: Internal Assessment

For Elective Manipuri subjects, the Internal Assessment shall carry a total of 20 marks. Of these, 10 marks shall be allotted to the Periodic Test, while the remaining 10 marks shall be awarded on the basis of the individual Field Work report submitted by each student and a subsequent viva voce.

1. The Periodic Test shall be conducted three times during an academic year. The First Periodic Test shall be held during June–July, the Second Periodic Test during August–September, and the Third Periodic Test during October–November. The final marks for the Periodic Test component shall be calculated on the basis of the average marks obtained in these best two out of three tests.

However, for the ongoing academic year 2026, as this assessment system is being introduced for the first time, only two Periodic Tests shall be conducted. The First Periodic Test shall be held during August–September, and the Second Periodic Test shall be conducted during October–November. The final marks for the Periodic Test component shall be determined on the basis of the average marks obtained in these two tests.

2. Each student shall submit an individual Field Work report, which shall carry 10 marks. The Field Work shall be undertaken in areas relevant to Manipuri Language and Literature or the Cultural Heritage of Manipur. The Field Work shall be organised in the following order: **Title Page, Certificate, Acknowledgement, Objective, Introduction, General Findings, Conclusion, Recommendations and Sources/ References.** The structure of the report should adhere to the given guidelines. Viva Voce shall follow after the submission of the report.

Field Work Report: 7 marks

Viva Voce: 3 marks
